

Special Education

- An IEP must be in place for students by October 15th.



Teacher Performance Appraisa

- Some of our teaching staff will be formally supervised this year based on the experienced teacher's five year evaluation cycle. Each of these teachers will be observed once and will receive one Teacher Performance Appraisal report
- NTIP teachers will be observed twice and receive a Teacher Performance Appraisals following each observation
- New: Occasional Teachers serving a LTO long 4 months or longer will receive an evaluation
- We will know who the 'chosen ones' are the second week of September
